

The data regarding services established and available in Belgium has been updated in September 2017, based on information given by CSA (Conseil Supérieur de l'Audiovisuel de la Communauté française) for the French community and by VRM (Vlaamse Regulator voor de Media) for the Flemish community. The Observatory may have supplemented the data provided, in particular as regards ownership or distribution, and may have harmonized some of the information given (e.g. linguistic versions or genres). Please note that: The list of local channels is not systematically updated. MAVISE only tracks the most significant on-demand services. They have been selected by the Observatory based on different sources. Since the audiovisual landscapes are distinct in the various communities of Belgium, four different pages were created in MAVISE: - The BELGIUM page displays population and equipment data and the list of companies operating in the country; - The various Communities pages (Flemish, French and German speaking Communities) display the licensing authorities relevant for each Community and the lists of channels available in the Community.
